MEETINGS DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Pursuant to Public Act 101-0640 and City of Markham Ordinance 20-O-2272, the Mayor, as head of the Public Body, has determined that the holding of an in-person meeting at the regular meeting location without limiting capacity is not feasible, practical, or prudent due to the declared disaster.
